Approval of April 14, 2014 Minutes....Chuck Rounds made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted. Motion was seconded and passed.

Select Board/Planning Board relationship

Frank opened this discussion referencing his letter to the Select Board of September 11, 2013. He offered several instances to support this observation over the course of the last year.

The purpose of the meeting will be to discuss the majority of topics listed in Frank's letter of September 11, 2013 in order that all parties can contribute to finding ways to better serve the residents, non residents and those elected individuals who are charged with the responsibility to administer the Town ordinance.

KVCOG recommendations to correct and improve the Land Use Ordinance.

The Board discussed the submission report made by Chris Huck KVCOG Planning Director.

We agreed that a possible effective use of his expertise and familiarity with our ordinance and those of other towns would be to inquire whether he would be available to rewrite our ordinance with our oversight. Jeanne Siviski volunteered to research this approach and report her findings to the Board. Depending upon her findings the Board may use this opportunity to enhance the ordinance as a way to further emphasize to town governance the need to revisit our regulations, procedures and relationships from time to time.
