Selectpersons Meeting June 12, 2013

Call to order: Mary Lee Rounds called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM

Mary Lee Rounds will order two *dead end* signs, one for the Danforth Road and one for the Cookson Road.

Bids were opened for paving 1200 feet of the Bog Road. The bid from Bard Paving was accepted. The price for paving 1200 feet at 2 inches compacted base coat was \$24,450.

Beverly Bradstreet reported the budget is on schedule.

Motion was made to approve and sign the Somerset Communication contract, all in favor and passed.

Bounce house for Albion's field day was approved.

Resident from the Knights Road requested a 25MPH sign at the end of the road, stating there is one at the Unity end of the road. He complained people are driving over the speed limit endangering his Grandchildren.

Winston Higgins reported the work on Cookson Road will be complete in a day or two. Mr. Gatti, who lives at the end of the Cookson Road, thanked the town for the upgrade to the road. The road has been raised and crowned so the water will run off and not damage the gravel road.

Fire Chief, Andy Clark reported he has to recall equipment from five volunteer that have not participated in meeting or reported for call. Andy said it is getting harder to recruit and retain volunteer fire fighters. Albion Fire and Rescue has received 110 calls in the first five months of 2013.

NITRAM has made a request to put-up the town's sand for the upcoming road maintenance season. Mary Lee Rounds told them [we do not have the money to pay you at this time, however if you want to wait and get paid you may put-up the sand and Albion will pay for the salt at this time].
