One of Albion Volunteers fire department trucks needs repair at a cost of approximately \$4000.00. Andy Clark our Fire Chief will review his budget to see if there is money to spend if not an emergency town meeting will be call to vote on the money needed.

Abatement property tax was signed for Lisa Forton in the amount of \$3121.85

Supplemental property tax was signed for Joseph Forton in the amount of \$1497.85

Complaints were made about missing sign for ***Quaker Hill Road*** and there is no ***Dead End*** sign on the Cookson Road.

The Town of Albion will rent a chipper for one week, Winston Higgins will cut and chip brush on the side of the roads.

Dialog was held about putting down some gravel by the rear entrance of the Besse Building, there is a drop-off from the pavement to the gravel that is a trip hazard.

The Albion Town office has received request from charitable organizations for money. They will need ten signatures from Albion residents to be eligible for consideration. They will need approval from the budget committee and voted on at the annual town meeting.
